Holiday Recipe - Gingerbread Man



Ingredients:

140g unsalted butter
100g dark muscovado sugar
3 tbsp golden syrup
350g plain flour
1 tsp bicarbonate soda
2 tsp ground ginger
1 tsp ground cinnamon
2 balls stem ginger from a jar

50g icing sugar

A few cherries/raisins/sultanas/smarties
(optional, to decorate)

STEP 1: Heat oven to 200C/392F, or 180C/356F fan, or gas 6. Line 2 baking sheets with baking parchment

STEP 2: Melt butter, sugar and syrup in a pan. Mix flour, soda, spices and a pinch of salt in a bowl. Stir the butter mix and chopped ginger to make a stiff-ish dough

STEP 3: Wait until cool enough to handle, and then roll out dough to about 5mm thick. Stamp out gingerbread men, and then press the trimmings together and re-roll until all of the dough has been used

STEP 4: Lift gingerbread men onto baking sheets. Bake for 12 minutes until golden. Leave to cool for 10 minutes

STEP 5: To decorate, mix icing sugar with a few drops of water until thick and smooth. Spoon icing into a food bag, snip off the a tiny bit from the corner, and squeeze to draw eyes and buttons. Leave to set

STEP 6: Add other decorations of your choice, such as cherries, raisins, sultanas and smarties

And there you have it: fresh, tasty, classic gingerbread men. Share these with your family and friends this holiday season. Bon appetit!
