

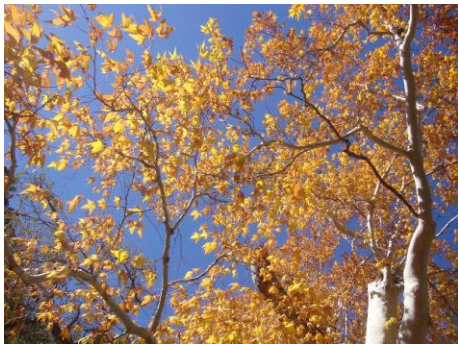
Team YANTSU Newsletter

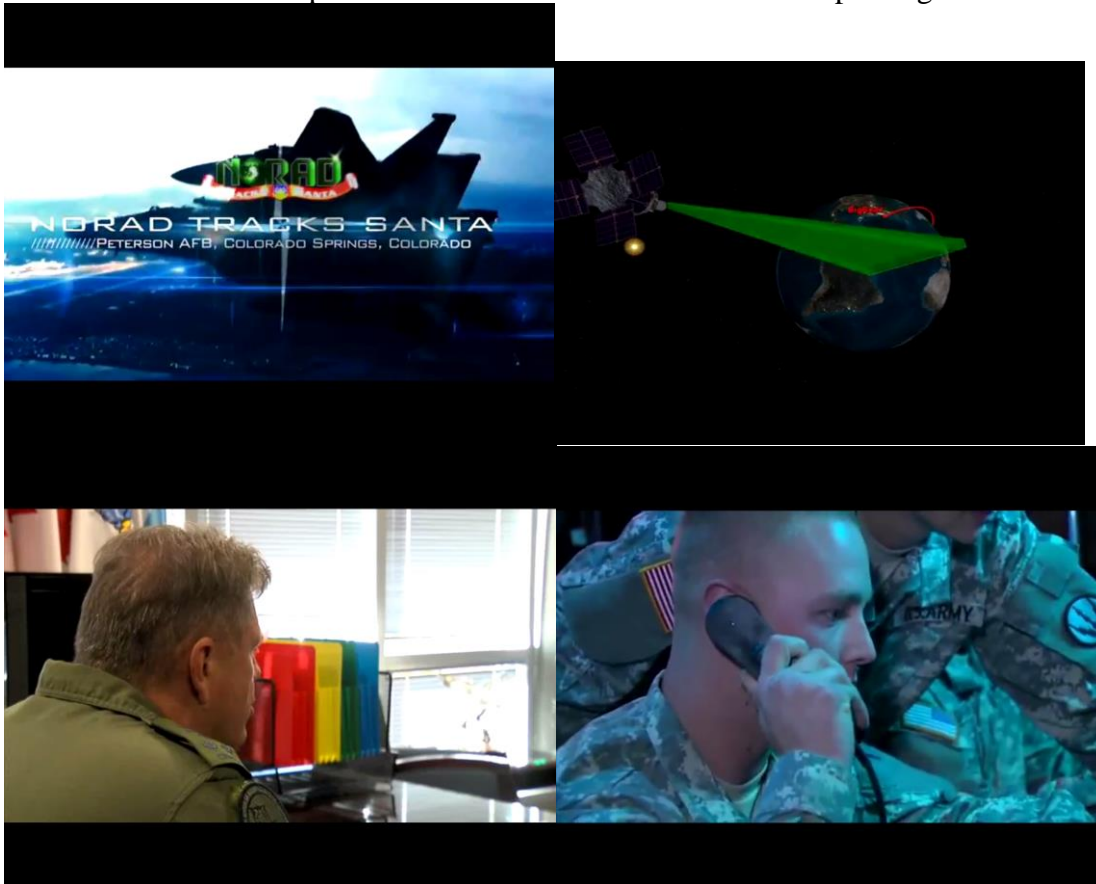
