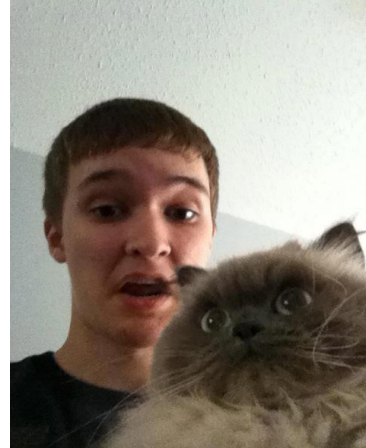
Synopsis
